

Procedures to create a Commission Schedules

These procedures show how to create a new commission schedule in VTXML.

Note: You will need to know the rates that are to be used in the commission schedule and verify that the rates are available in VTXml before creating the commission schedule. Refer to the Creating a Rate Table document to find these instructions.

Background: Commission schedules can have one or several commission options. You need to create an option record for each combination of Option code and commission event. For example, we are creating a commission schedule with 3 options (Options 1, 2 and 3). Each option has 4 records – one record for each of the 4 commission events (Cash with App, Additional Premium, External Exchange and Internal Exchange). The completed commission scheduled will have 12 option records (3 options x 4 commission events).

Procedures to create a new commission schedule:

- 1. Click on Commission Rates & Schedules from the left hand navigation
- 2. Click Add

- 3. Type in the commission schedule information:
 - a) Type in the Carrier Facing Description
 - b) Type in an Effective Date, if required
 - c) Type in an Expiration Date, if required
- 4. Click on 'Add' in the Associated Commission Rates popup box to add a commission option:
 - a) Type in a Carrier Facing Description to describe the Commission Option. This should be unique.
 - b) Type in a Commission Option Code
 - c) Select a Commission Event from the drop down list box
 - d) Select a Commission Type from the drop down list box, if appropriate for the option
 - e) Select a Rate Table from the drop down list box



- f) Click Save & Return
- 5. Repeat steps above for all commission options and events.
- 6. Click Save & Return to save the commission schedule

- 4. Click on the Name link in the Associated Commission Rates popup box to update a commission option:
 - a) Type in a Carrier Facing Description to describe the Commission Option. This should be unique.
 - b) Type in a Commission Option Code
 - c) Select a Commission Event from the drop down list box
 - d) Select a Commission Type from the drop down list box, if appropriate for the option
 - e) Select a Rate Table from the drop down list box
 - f) Click Save & Return
- 5. Repeat steps above for all commission options and events.
- 6. Click Save & Return to save the commission schedule
