


VTXml July 30 2012 Enhancement Release

1) Output Build History – Re-launch builds

The Output Build History page has been updated to allow a previously run build to be re-launched with associated active criteria. A new column has been added with a checkbox to allow multiple builds to be selected and relaunched.

The Set to Prod and Prod checklist columns have been removed as the Transport logic has been enhanced to send Non WIN builds to authorized Intended Receivers (For example, Morningstar and Insurance Technologies).

Select the Builds to be included and click the Relaunch button on the left. The Relaunch button will float and move with the scroll bar offering easy access. The page will then automatically refresh after 2 seconds and display the builds at the top of the page as new individual build rows.



The build will run with the original active specified criteria. If a WIN has been cleaned up or deleted the build will only include the initially specified active WINs and all Production data in the build.



2) Reports – Carrier specific VTXml user list

Carriers can now run a report showing all of their VTXml users. Reports can be found under Administration Tools – Reports. Select Users with VTXml access from the drop down and click Submit.



The report will show the User Name, Login ID, Security Group, LOBs and last Update Date.





3) Activity Log – Filter by User update (WIN only)

The Activity Log will be updated to only include users in the User filter which have actually made changes within the last 90 days. The Screen filter has also been updated to include an * by any page which is affected by an Active WIN. This should help in testing to know which pages should be looked at during review.



4) Activity Log – Duplicate rows cleanup (WIN only)

The Activity Log has also been updated to correct an issue where checklists where duplicating entries in the Activity Log.
