


# **VTXml Distribution Agreement Enhancement**

#### 1) Ability to automatically include a Permanent WIN with any output

VTXml now allows the user to specify if a WIN should always be included with a specific output. There are use cases where the platforms are different and a Permanent WIN has been created to manage these differences. The risk has been remembering to include these Permanent WINs when generating output.


Users can now specify the Intended Receiver/Version for which a WIN should automatically be included when generating output. This can be done when adding a new WIN or to an existing WIN.

When adding a new WIN a new checkbox called Permanent WIN For: has been added to the screen. The selections are based on the versions each Carrier has access to. Multiple Intended Receivers/Versions can be specified.






An existing WIN can be updated to add this new functionality by clicking Change WIN Description.






If no additional WINs are needed the user need only generate the output and not specify any WINs to include. A message will appear notifying the user a Permanent WIN has been included and which WIN it was.




If additional WINs need to be included, they can be added as needed. If you do not check the Permanent WIN a message will be generated stating the Permanent WIN was included.





If the Permanent WIN is included with the other WINs then the message will not be generated.



Order still matters and will be determined by the order you select the WINs and then the Release Date of the Permanent WIN.


**Tip:** When Re-launching a PPfA, the output will include all of the Permanent WINs included with the original output. If the Permanent Win is no longer required, Change WIN Description must be used to deselect the Intended Receiver/Version and then create a new output for the product(s) with the desired WINs. The Output History screen will always show the WINs which were included with the build.



#### 2) Ability to specify InvestProducts as Inactive

The Investment Options screen has been updated to allow an InvestProduct to be specified as Inactive – the same functionality we added for Products and Features. This will allow the Investment Option screen to be decluttered if funds are not being used or are not used for everyday use.


A new dropdown called Inactive Indicator has been added to specify a specific fund as Inactive.



This needs to be updated in a WIN and cleaned up before being effective. Best Practice would be to add a new WIN, make the needed updates and then cleanup the WIN.




A new checkbox called Include Inactive Funds has been added to the Filter page of the Investment Options screen. This should be checked if Investment Options have been specified as Inactive.



**Tip:** To search for just Inactive Investment Options, Check the Include Inactive Funds and type Inactive in the search box. This will only return Investment Options with Inactive in the ProductCode, Name, Short Name, Carrier Facing Description or Fund Manager.



The Carrier Facing Description is updated with text {\*\*Inactive\*\*} if an Investment Option is specified as Inactive.






### 3) Adding Reward to Policy Product

A new popup has been added to the Product Profiles screen. This object will only appear in version 2.20 and above. Neither Platform currently supports this object on PolicyProduct. This object is being added for future support.


The Platforms currently do support Reward within FeatureOptProduct. A new column has been added to the grid to display the Reward Percent.





### 4) Distributor Config Payout Option Exclusions:

Adding a new popup to Distributor Config to allow Payout options to be excluded.



A single dropdown within Payout Option Exclusions called Payout Option will allow the specified Payout Options to be excluded. The dropdown shows both the 2.16 and 2.20 ACORD type code names along with the Payout Option carrier facing description if modeled.






## 5) Reporting Services:

#### **Policy Product by Jurisdiction**

A new report has been added to query all of the Policy Products and the Jurisdictions associated to them. This report is sorted by Jurisdiction. As with all reports, they can be downloaded to excel and a filter can be applied to get to the specific detail required.



#### **Feature and Feature Options**

This existing report has been updated to now include the actual Feature name and Feature Option name as additional columns in the report. This may help in the recent Raymond James request regarding supported features.
